## MEET OUR NEW DEPUTY - ANTONIO BARFIELD

Deputy Antonio Barfield has a total of 11 years of service in Law Enforcement. Deputy Barfield began his Law Enforcement career with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ), as a Correctional Officer in 2008. He stayed with TDCJ for a total of 5 years when he left as a Sergeant to pursue a new beginning at the Harris County Sheriff's Office (HCSO) where he was hired as a Detentions Officer, in General Population. He was

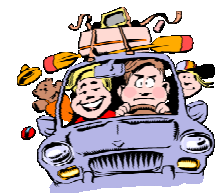
soon moved to Administration Segregation (Lockdown). He began the process of becoming a member of the Detention Command Containment Team (DCCT). While working at HCSO Deputy Barfield enrolled in and attended the University of Houston-Downtown Police Academy. After completing the Police Academy, Deputy Barfield was hired in September of 2016 as a Patrol Deputy with the



Harris County Precinct One Constable's Office where he is currently assigned to our RACS contract.

## Welcome New Neighbors!

**What is RACS?** The Rice Area Constable Service is a service that provides added security to our neighborhood. We accomplish this by joining together several subdivisions to contract with the Harris County Constable Service for the services of our deputy.

Our deputy constable is a state certified law enforcement officer who has the authority to *make arrests and issue tickets*.

We are provided with highly visible street patrolling, quick response times to calls for



assistance, dispatched patrol on call 24 hours a day - 7 days a week, vacation watches, and special watches. This is not a "second" job for our deputy, but his full time job, eight hours a day, 5 days a week.

If you are planning your summer vacation, don't forget about our vacation watch program. As a member of RACS, you can let Precinct One know when you will be away. Our deputy will then check on your home, making sure it's secure by looking for signs of forced entry.

**VACATION WATCH PROCEDURE**

A new procedure was established for submitting a vacation watch request. Previously, you were able to access and submit the form online. However, due to nonmember use, the website had to be locked. Now you will need to email [racpatrol@gmail.com](mailto:racpatrol@gmail.com) and the form will be emailed to you. It is a fillable PDF, so all you have to do is fill it out like you would have online. Next just save it as a PDF so that the

file name includes either your name or address, then email it back as an attachment. It is then sent in for you. This will prevent the use of this service by non-members. If you do not have email, please indicate on the enrollment form that you need the form mailed to you.

As before, your vacation watch still needs to be sent 3-5 days before you leave.
